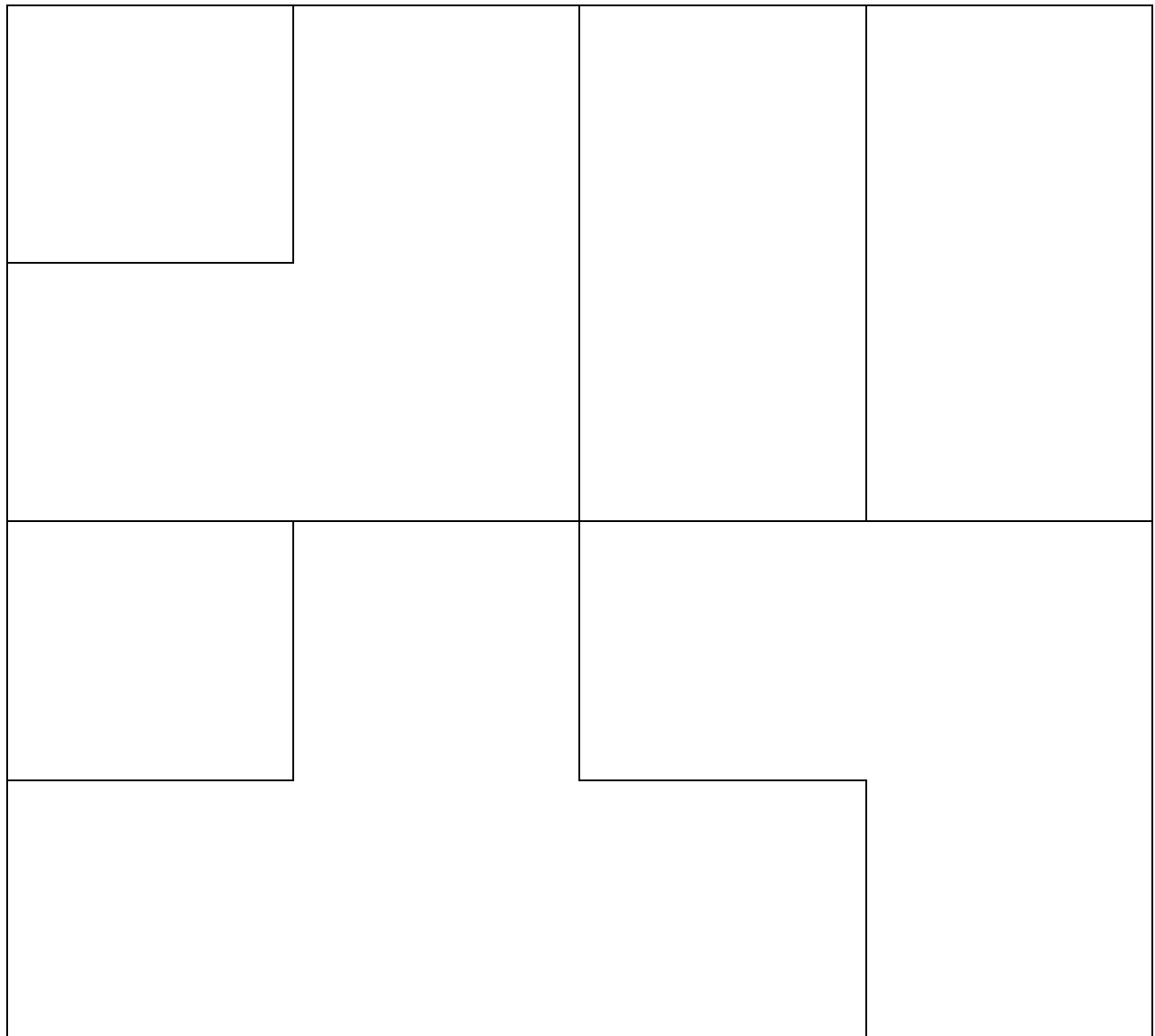


# TETRA Game

The root "tetra" means "four". There are "four" different shapes used in this game. Copy the game pieces onto "four" different color sheets of paper and cut apart the "four" different shapes. Place all of the shapes into a small container or bag.

To play the game, the student reaches into the container or bag and pulls out one shape and places it on the game board. The object of the game is to fill in all of the spaces on the 4x4 game board without overlapping any shapes. If the student draws a shape that cannot be placed on the game board without overlapping part of another shape, the game is over.
