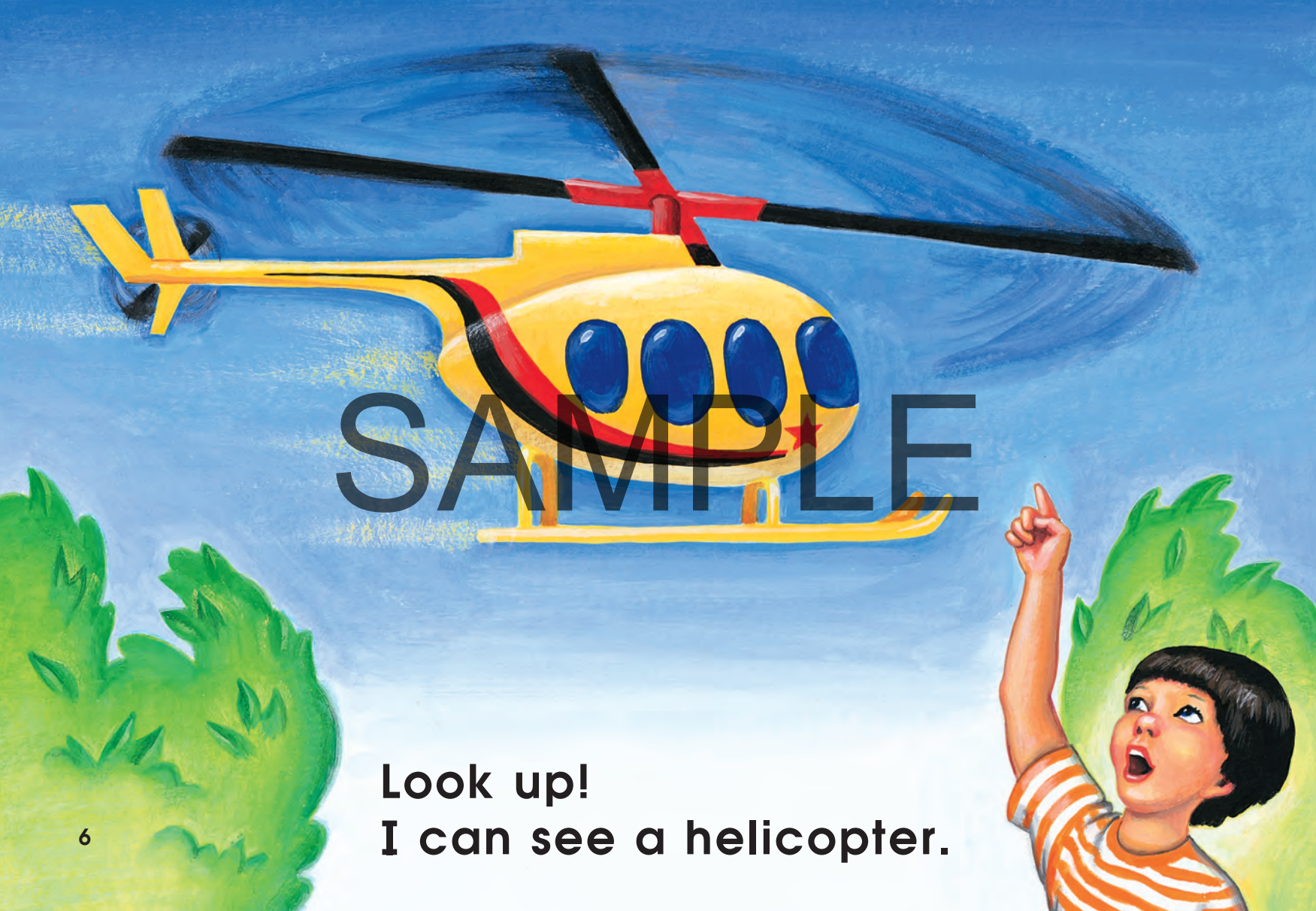

# Look Up! What Can I See?

## Materials

- ◆ cotton balls
- ◆ large sheets of blue construction paper
- ◆ crayons or markers
- ◆ glue

## Sight Word Activity

### Cotton Words

Give each student several cotton balls and a large sheet of blue construction paper. Assign a sight word to each student. Have students write their word on their paper. Ask them to write their word in large letters so it fills most of the paper. Then, have students trace the letters with glue and place cotton balls over the glue until the entire word is covered. Challenge students to use their word in a sentence and write the sentence on their paper. Invite them to illustrate their sentence. Combine all the completed pages to create a class book. Encourage students to touch the words as they read the book.
